

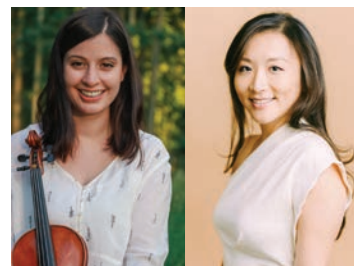
Friends of Westwood Library & Los Angeles Musical Salon present

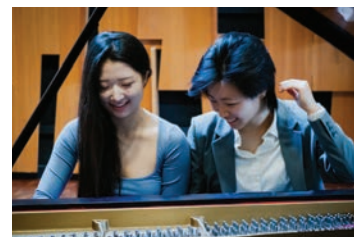
FIATO QUARTET MARCH 9 • SUNDAY • 2:30 PM
